TWENTY-SECOND BRIEFING NOTE ON THE EXTRAORDINARY FLOODS CAUSED BY THE DANA (CUT-OFF LOW) FROM 26 OCTOBER TO 4 NOVEMBER 2024 IN VALENCIA, ANDALUSIA, CATALONIA, CASTILLA-LA MANCHA, THE BALEARIC ISLANDS, ARAGON AND OTHER AREAS AND THE MANAGEMENT OF THE COMPENSATION TO BE ASSUMED BY CONSORCIO DE COMPENSACIÓN DE SEGUROS (CCS) ATTACHED TO THE MINISTRY OF ECONOMY, TRADE AND BUSINESS

In relation to the serious situation caused by the DANA (cut-off low pressure system) that has produced **from 26 October to 4 November 2024** extensive damage due to flooding and windstorms in large areas of the east and south of the Iberian Peninsula and the Balearic Islands, particularly the tragic floods in Valencia and Albacete on 29 October, Consorcio de Compensación de Seguros (CCS) reports the following:

1. As of 8 a.m. on 30 July 2025 CCS has filed 249,300 claims, of which 2,445 have been received since 30 April 2025.

238,014 of these claims (95.4 % of the total) are located in the province of Valencia.

- 2. Of the 249,456 total claims, 4,289 are for business interruption and 265 for personal injury. The remaining 244,902 claims are for property damage.
- 3. Of the 249,191 claims for property damage and business interruption, 33,137 have been rejected due to duplication or lack of coverage. As of this date and time, 205,639 claims have been paid, for a cumulative amount of €3,447,064,422, broken down by type of exposure as follows:

60,134 payouts for €1,013,268,360 Residential properties: 129,210 payouts for €1,163,325,528 Motor vehicles: 11,911 payouts for €669,417,611 Shops, warehouses and other risks: 779 payouts for €30,007,953 Offices: 3,577 payouts for €562,226,483 Industrial risks: 28 payouts for €8,818,487 Infrastructure:

In other words, 241,793 claims for property damage and business interruption have been managed¹, 97.0% of the claims for property damage and business interruption received, leaving 7,398 claims currently at different stages of damage assessment process by loss adjusters, and taking into account that

¹ Claims that have been paid in full or in part, those that have been rejected, and those whose final processing is on hold, pending for reasons beyond the control of CCS, are counted as managed claims.



2,445 of the total number of claims received have been received in the last three months.

The following table details the management by type of exposure in property damage and business interruption: claims received, completed, with payments on account, and pending by type of exposure. The percentages refer to the total number of claims received in each type of exposure.

In summary, 97.0% (95.3% + 1.8%) of claims received for all type of exposure have been managed, with the following breakdown by type of exposure:

•	Residential properties:	96.7%
•	Motor vehicles:	98.4%
•	Shops, warehouses and other risks:	91.5%
•	Offices:	90.9%
•	Industrial risks:	84.6%
•	Infrastructure:	58.1%

Of the 3.0% of claims pending, 20.2% are claims submitted within the last 90 days.

These figures include the payment by CCS of all the claims submitted by the insurance companies arising from the special operating procedure between CCS and the insurance companies for the collaboration of the insurance companies in the



management and assessment of damage caused to vehicles, homes, shops and offices, of those files that have been sent complete by the insurance companies to the CCS.

The Annex below details the payments per municipality for those municipalities with more than 100 compensation claims.

- 4. CCS currently estimates the total cost of this event to be around 4.8 billion euros.
- 5. CCS will continue to update these briefing notes as the management of the loss event advances.
